


Our prayer chain prays each day in their home for the prayer concerns of all who call us. We hope to give you comfort and strength. All calls are kept in confidence.

As you can see above, our balance in our Parish increased by \$10,812 in April. Thank you all for your generous contributions each month. Please keep in mind that our expenses are lower than normal since we are not supporting a full-time Pastor at Bethany Lutheran Church. We also received a large donation \$6,000.00 from Little Friends School in April 2022. Thank you, Little Friends, we love you!

Our "Annual Stewardship Drive" has ended, thank you to all who completed the "Count Me In"! I certainly appreciate your participation in our drive.

As we move into Summer for 2022, we must continue to search for a full time Pastor. It would be wonderful to find one who can lead our congregation for the beginning of Fall Season and into Advent/Christmas Season this year. 




