



Hello Bethany! Can you believe that it's almost May already? This year is flying by!

I want to thank everyone for participating in the ELCA 40 Days of Giving this past Lent season. It was nice to spend time together, although there were only a few of us that were able to come together on our Wednesday Zoom evenings. I hope that those were as meaningful to you as it was to me!

As many as 811 million people around the world are undernourished. Your gifts matter - in Indonesia, the United States, Tanzania, and other countries all around the world. As church, our calling is not merely to minister to our neighbors but to bear witness to the "new thing" God is doing in our world, a new community God is making possible. This is not easy work, but we are not alone.

God is with us along the way, inspiring hope and courage and revealing Godself in the neighbors we encounter. We know that this Lenten journey is not the end.
