

#### Message from the Pastor

On the first day of the week, when we met to break bread..." Acts 20:7

This month we will begin having communion every week. We will be joining with an ancient tradition going back to the early church of Acts in which followers of Jesus enjoy this sacred meal with one another frequently and with joy.

In this meal, "God nourishes faith, forgives sin, and calls us to be witnesses to the Gospel" (Use of the Means of Grace 36). Communion is one of the two sacraments, the two places in which God has promised to be present to us, and thus frequent participation of this gift is preferred.

Going as far back as the reformation we see evidence that weekly communion was the norm and expectation for Lutheran churches. The Apology of the Augsburg Confession, written in September 1531, says that "Lutheran congregations celebrate the Holy Communion every Sunday and festival" (Use of the Means of Grace 39).

Through cultural and historical forces too varied to sum up, many congregations moved to less frequent celebration of communion over the past 500 years, with many churches communing every two weeks or less. Nevertheless, the ELCA began a push to restore weekly communion in the middle of the twentieth century. This is evident in numerous official documents from the 1980's and 1990's, including the Use of the Means of Grace published in 1997. Even in our hymnal one can see the change in the number of settings for services with communion in comparison to the single setting offered for service of the Word.

Christ invites us to come to the table, be filled with wine and bread. To know and feel and believe and taste God's love for us. Because while we can experience Christ anywhere, communion is one of two places we can know he is present with us.

So let us come and be filled by the lifegiving body and blood of our Lord. Let us be fed and strengthened to go out into the world and share the love we have received. Let us live in the abundant table which Jesus has spread before us as we long for the feast to come.

#### Taste and see that the Lord is good. Thanks be to God.


#### **Property Committee**
